- (4) Format of Play : ➤ Golfers will record the gross for each hole and System 36 will assign Merit Points to the golfers for each hole, based on their actual gross less the par for that hole as follows:

|-------------|-----------------|
| 2 or more | = 0 Merit Point |
| 1 | = 1 Merit Point |
| 0 | = 2 Merit Point |
| Less than 0 | = 2 Merit Point |
- The System will then use this computed handicap to compute the golfers' stableford ranking in ONE division
- In the event of ties on scores, the Local Club count-back system shall apply.
- All play shall be from white tees for men and red tees for ladies (if applicable).
- In the event that the game is disrupted by bad weather, a lucky draw will be held to determine the winners for the prizes.
- As this is a private tournament, any decision made in respect of the tournament by the organizer shall be final.
- (5) Refreshment & other charges : ➤ Two bottles of mineral water and one bottle of Gatorade will be provided for each participant.
- Two bottles of beer will be provided during play at designated holes. Beer will be provided during lunch. All other refreshments or food consumed at the half-way house or the club house shall be borne by the participants.

Hole	Dist	What's happening?	Description
1	325 m	Photo	The group with the funniest pose shall win a free flight at Horizon Hills Golf & Country Club.
2	472 m	Index 1 Par 5	This hole is too difficult for us to distract you with novelty games.
3	141 m	Nearest to pin 	Each golfer is allowed to pay SGD 10 for one mulligan. Only balls on green are counted. Prize: SGD 250 JetStar Asia voucher.
4	295 m	Nearest to line 	Not the usual straight hole for nearest to line. It is a dog leg right over water. (Hint: Bunker on the left is 205 m)
5	324 m	Satay & Beer 	Try the local satay and enjoy your beer
6	455 m	Longest drive 	Whack the ball as hard as you can. Make sure that it stays on the fairway. The winner gets a Nike putter.
7	361 m	Buaya hole 	Whoever's ball lands nearest to the crocodile will win the "Mr. Buaya" award and a special prize.
8	150 m	Drive from blue tee	Select one guy from the flight to tee off from the blue tee (160 m) with a driver. Nearest to pin - a box of golf balls for the flight.
9	330 m	Trust your buddy's driver	You must have faith that your friend's "equipment" can perform as mighty as yours. Everyone shall tee off with your friend's driver.
10	327 m	Nearest to line 	Another challenging dog leg right. Do not be intimidated by the water. The winner takes home a Callaway Odyssey Putter.
11	348 m	Suzuki Hole-in-2 	In this tricky dog-leg left hole, you stand to win a <u>Suzuki Swift JWRC</u> * if you get an eagle. Sorry, you cannot buy a mulligan. * COE not included. Terms and conditions applied.
12	155 m	Nearest to pin 	Each golfer are allowed to pay SGD 10 for one mulligan. Only balls on green are counted. Prize: SGD 250 JetStar Asia voucher.
13	443 m	Ramly Burger 	Enjoy the famous Ramly Burger at the end of the hole.
14	369 m	Longest drive 	Hammer your (golf) ball. Stay on the fairway. The winner gets a Nike putter.

Hole 2 - Index 1 Hole!

This hole is too difficult for us to distract you with novelty games. Stay focused on course management.

Frankly, a bogey for this hole is considered an achievement for an average golfer.



Hole 3 - Nearest To Pin

Try to place the ball as close to the pin as you can. Only balls on the green are eligible for the prize.

Each golfer is allowed to buy one mulligan at SGD 10. You may play your next shot from the better ball.

Remember to write your name on the flag if your ball is nearer to the pin than the flag.

Hole 4 - Nearest To Line

Try to place the ball as close to the line as possible. The bunker on the left is about 200 m away so you can use that as a gauge as to the direction you want to aim.

In the event when more than one ball land exactly on the line, the further one prevails.

Hole 5 - Satay & Beer

We expect the lunch to be served late so we catered satay for you to fill your stomach during the game.

Hole 12 - Nearest To Pin

Hole 16 - Drive On!

After teeing off, we allow you to take another shot to go for the green which is only 258 m away. Who knows, with a strong tailwind and good night's sleep, you may send your ball safely to the green with your driver.

If you take another shot to attack the green, you can choose the better ball to continue with your second shot.

Hole 17 – Stay Dry

If your ball finds the water, you have to tee off again and again until it lands on dry land (regardless of green or rough).

To cross the water, you only need to carry 74 m. There is no reason why you cannot clear the water ... of course unless you are really thirsty or you were from the Naval Diver unit during your national service.

Prize: There will be a consolation prize for the golfer who lose the most balls in the water.



Hole 18 – Pinless Hole

Studies have shown that average golfers play better when there is no pin on the green because they always aim for the centre of the green and will avoid trouble with water and bunkers. As such, we try to help you achieve a better score by removing the pin from this hole.

Hint: For the pros who are upset that there is no pin to aim for, you may try hitting the ball close to the water on the right-side of the green.
