



欢乐在今宵 解除烦恼十大高招

处在 21世纪的 "e"时代,急速变迁的环境和竞争激烈的生活,使现代人每天都要面对形形色色的压力。有些人面对压力,愈活愈有冲劲。有些人面对压力,感到焦虑与无助。其实生活在现代社会中,时刻都会有压力,压力也是一种推动力,为生活增添色彩。要想生活在一个无忧无虑的"极乐世界"中,那也只是一种幻想。我们来到这五花八门的世界也就是这么一遭而已,为何不把烦恼抛在一边,来个"欢乐在今宵"。

(2) 转移方式

不是教您"移情别恋", 而是主动参加有益身心健康的活动, 或积极参与公教校友会的活动如中秋赏月、新春团拜, 或像今晚的双庆晚宴。转移注意力以松弛精神紧张。

(3) 升华方式

不要只是向"钱"看,也要向"前"看。树立远大的人生追求目标,确立崇高的理想,好好学习,天天向上,发愤图强,使自己精神有所寄托,集中火力,发挥自己的特长。站在泰山之巅,心胸更开阔,人生意境和精神境界并达到新的飞跃升华,高唱"无限风光在险峰"。

(4) 渲泄与谈心



(5) 自我克服

遇到精神刺激后,保持心平气和,主动自 我克制,"以退为进"、"以柔克刚",便 可化险为夷。

(6) 培养幽默

我们的教育与文化往往抑制 幽默,它告诉我们做人要一 本正经,让我们以为成长就 是"正经八百",而"正经" 几乎等于严肃——人们再 也不懂得微笑或狂笑,每 天板着一个严肃的脸孔, 艺人维克·包吉(Victor



(7) 生命在于运动

(8) 要敢于维护自己的利益

要学习对一些不合理,过高的要求,不必感到内疚而说声 "不"。否则上司或友人看你"行",把一切责任与事务交给 你承受,那时候,你真的会给压到四肢无力。

(9) 回归自然

转换一下生活环境,不要成天只在办公室里工作,或整天 跑百货公司。到乡村、公园、海滩,赤脚走走,望望蓝天, 呼吸大自然新鲜空气,有助于心境平静。

(10) 善用时间

现代生活,分秒必争,妥善安排时间。小时候我们读过"一寸光阴一寸金,寸金难买寸光阴"。善用时间,可帮我们减轻压力,增加工作效率,创造更多的休闲时间。意志力高、组织能力强及富有自律性都是一个善用时间的人所应有的条件。今晚您出席"双庆晚宴"已证明您是一个懂得惜缘与善用时间的人。

陈志成同学 | 第四届(1973/74) 第五届(1974/75) 第六届(1975/76)

陈志成校友五十年代就读高中,是本校早期学生之一。肄业后进入社会工作。1957年代表人民行动党参加市议会选举,当选市议员,开始为民服务。随后,当选立法议会议员,国会议员,以及担任国会执政党的党督。1959年至1984年之间,先后受委出任新加坡政府的内政部、财政部、社会发展部和贸易工业部的政务次长和高级政务次长。从政达27年之久,为争取新加坡独立和建国作出了贡献。

他于 1984 年告别政坛后投入教育工作,热心推广国际教育,为发扬百年树人的精神,提倡培养英才的宗旨,在新加坡创办了新加坡 ISS 国际学校、美国学院、美国教育中心,又在北京开办了北京 BISS 国际学校、北京国际管理专修学院。他是这五所院校的创办人兼董事主席。

志成校友对母校的发展特别关心,1973年至1976年三度蝉联校友会会长。他在任期间,母校首任校长姚国华先生不幸逝世,于是发起举行追悼会以及发动设立姚国华奖学金,以奖励优秀学生。二十多年来该奖学金为培育人才,让很多学生受惠,深获各界好评。他卸下校友会会长,立即受委为顾问至今。虽然事业繁忙,他对母校和校友会一向关怀备至,给予多方支持,是深受尊敬的老校友。

林乃田同学 | 第九届(1978/79)

林乃田同学于 1950 年高中三毕业,并于同年考取剑桥甲等文凭。1956 年考获利物浦大学教育文凭,后就读伦敦大学,1959年取得学士学位(B.A.)(数学),1962 年取得 B.A(Hons)(中文及历史)。

乃田同学选择了神圣的教育为职业,历任国初主任、德新中学校长,并于1973年担任华中初级学院首任院长。1976年被调回教育部任助理提学司,直到1978年。

乃田同学于1978年担任校友会会长,在任期间,于1978年7月25日晚假华初礼堂举行音乐晚会,由台北儿童合唱团演出,场面热烈。1979年2月4日于水上游乐场举行校友联欢聚餐,反应热烈。乃田同学后因公务繁忙,一年后卸下会长职务。

乃田同学令弟乃燕同学也是公教校友,曾任德明中学校长十多年,是教育界前辈。两位同学可说为本地教育事业作出很大的 贡献。

欧进福同学 | 第十届(1979/1980) • 第十一届(1980/1981)

欧进福校友 1961年高中毕业离校后,先后在我国取得经济学士、和在美国取得硕士和博士学位。1972年至 1993年在新加坡大学执教。1976年欧校友从政,出任麟记区国会议员。次年开始受委为文化部政务次长,秉着饮水思源的优良传统,他出任第十届和第十一届校友会会长(1979年至 1981年)。

公教向来以双语教育,校风严谨卓称。当年严禁学生参与反殖运动和其他政治活动,对毕业生不无影响。纵观校友专业人才倍出,蜚声国际者也不少。教授、学者、名医、律师、建筑绘测专才、会计师等等各种专才比比皆是,独缺从政者,不无其背景原因。欧校友可谓开先河者。

若和今日我校校友活跃政坛情况相比,真有天渊之别。欧校友领导校友会期间,在维多利亚剧院举行的新春文娱晚会曾掀起高潮。无奈政务繁忙,欧校友终于1981年卸下会长之职并即被推举任我会顾问至今。

自 1997 年起,欧校友被委为外交部政务部长兼任我国首位丹戎巴葛区市长。他不但没有因身负国家重任,政务繁忙而疏 离母校和校友会。相反的,他对母校和校友会关怀有加,提起母校和校友会,欧校友总是义不容辞,这也许得归功于母校 的优良传统教诲,公教精神。

陈汉平同学 | 第十二届(1981/82) ● 第十五届(1984/85)

陈汉平校友是华校改制后的第一批毕业校友。当时华校由原有的初中三年和高中三年改为中学四年和高级中学二年,也就是现在的"O"水准和"A"水准。后来母校也和其他中学一样,取消高级中学,毕业生都需转到初级学院去。离校后汉平校友先后在我国前南洋大学和美国纽约州立大学取得学士、硕士和博士学位。回国后即参与校友会活动。他对母校感情特别深厚,以身为公教校友为荣。他也坚持下一代一定要回公教受教育。他认为,公教创校主倡双语教育,并一直以此卓称。现在双语教育虽然已在全国普及化,但是优良的传统教育风气并非俯首皆是。良禽尚且择木而栖,更何况是影响终身的教育。

1981年,他出任第12届校友会会长,积极扩展会务,并于1984年再任第15届会长。在二任期间,他作出了不少贡献。他发起春节回母校团拜的活动,得到当时我国文化部政务部长已故邝摄治校友的支持。当时出席人数虽然不多,仅数十人,却为后来每年举行的新春回校团拜打下了良好的基础。现在每年这个在母校举行的活动,出席人数均超过数百人。1984年,母校前校长孙继昌修士逝世,汉平校友领导校友会和母校联合在母校教堂举行追悼会并成立孙继昌修士数学/科学优异奖,每年颁发给最优秀的在籍学生,中、小学各二名以纪念孙修士对母校的贡献。

汉平校友现是我会顾问,仍然积极参与我会活动。像往日一样,在母校和校友会的活动中,总是可以见到他。

庄明元同学 | 第廿一届至第廿六届(1990/96)

庄明元同学现年 52 岁,1958 年由印尼棉兰岛抵达新加坡,并进入公教中学附小四年级,于1966 年高二毕业,是一位完全由母校培养的公教子弟。

就读公教期间,明元同学的美术水平极高,因此选择进入新大选修绘测系,并以绘测为终生事业。

在专业领域中,明元同学积极参与新加坡绘测师协会,并担任要职多年。其实,他在基层组织的活动更为活跃,因而受总统颁发了PBM(1986)BBM(1995)以表扬他的贡献。此外,他也参加了无数社团并担任要职,其中包括人协、特警部队、新加坡公益金、狮子会、洛阳小学咨委会(主席)等,他的确是一位热心社会,无私的为人民服务的公教子弟。

明元同学于1989年加入校友会执委,并于1990年开始被选为会长。他连续当了6年会长,是任期最久的会长。这数年间,他和执委们共同进退,合作无间,并与校方保持紧密联系。这期间,除了连续举行几次千人宴外,还为"双轨"增加彩色版与内容,为母校建设基金努力。劳爱华神父铜像和长青馆也是由许多热心校友与校友会合作,在这段

时间内搞出来的。

明元同学秉着校友会的优秀传统,于1996年自动引退,并推举曾士生同学接任会长。

CHSOBA supported our school in the following areas:

CHSOBA Scholarships | 校友会颁发"亲爱忠诚"奖学金

20 students were presented with the CHSOBA Scholarships this year. Since 1998, the scholarship recognises the academic performances of students enrolled into our Secondary One Level. The scholarship is one of the programs that helps to encourage more students and their parents to consider Catholic High as a school of choice for secondary education through the recognition and prestige of the awards. Ex-Principal Brother Joseph Chang presented the awards at this year's Chinese New Year Celebration in January.

School Assembly Speakers Series | 校友回校主持讲座

OBA leverages the large pool of our old boys' talents and expertise to share with our students in school on issues and topics during selected School Assemblies. This program provides an opportunity to our students to hear and learn from seasoned practitioners on the selected topics and issues. Students, and even staff often find perspectives presented very refreshing.

Stephen Yueng, an old boy who is a Citibanker, gave a talk on "Banking Finance and Economics" in August. Stephen explained the fundamentals of the financial world and how it works in simple language. His interactive approach, by way of a Quiz, drew enthusiastic responses from the students. Not least because there were Citibank pens given out for every answer given. Beside the regular subjects they learn in school, they now have an appreciation of the financial education that will make them wiser in understanding their environment.

Dr Yeo Seem Huat, our well known old boy pychiatrist went back to school this September again due to popular demand! This time Dr Yeo spoke on subjects related to mental preparation and stress management related to schooling and examinations. He brought a lively tune to our students. He shared with them not only the considerations, principles and techniques of mental and stress management, he also shared with them the larger pictures of life beyond schooling and examinations though they are neccessities.






